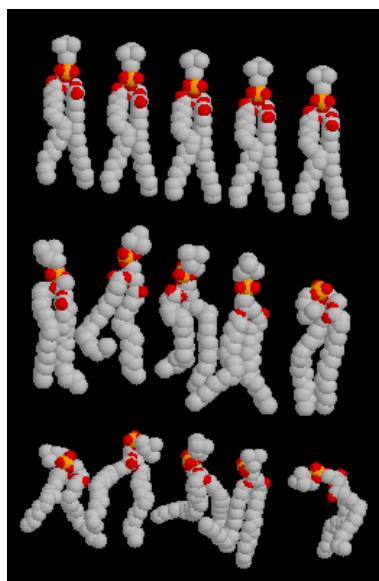

Dr. Black received his B.S in biology from Colorado State University in 1978 and a Ph.D. in cell biology from the University of Vermont in 1983. Since his work as a postdoctoral fellow at the University of California, Irvine, his research has been directed to define the biochemical process of how fat molecules get into cells. In his talk he will discuss his fascination with fat and how that has led to adventures as a traveling biochemist to Europe and Asia.
